<p>Telethon on WOAI (Channel 4) to benefit the SA Food Bank – scheduled for April 29th & 30th</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goal of \$2 million <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We would like to have \$1M committed in matching funds prior to start of telethon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$500K already committed in matching funds
<p>“Get Shift Done” - \$300K committed - which will be matched dollar for dollar by Shift Smart</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shiftsmart recently launched Get Shift Done to serve those in need during the COVID-19 crisis. Through the Shiftsmart Marketplace, workers can access paid shifts at local non-profits and fight hunger in their communities.

<p>Big Give Relief Fund</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$569,699 raised from 2,388 donors for 280 organizations <p>San Antonio Area Foundation and United Way COVID-19 Relief Fund</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The fund has distributed \$2.67M to 89 nonprofits to date • JLS Committee approved a \$500K match to the COVID-19 Fund <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Supporting the match is The Najim Charitable Foundation at \$100K & Harvey Najim at \$400K <i>(With the above support, the Najim Foundation & Harvey Najim, personally, to date have committed \$1M to the COVID-19 Fund)</i>
